



Dementia Friends Illinois

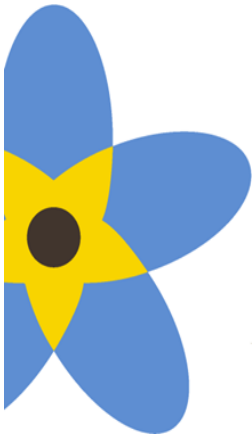
